

Modern Slavery Policy



The threshold for annual reporting on the Modern Slavery Act 2015 is an annual turnover of £36m.

Whilst Greyfriars Project Management is significantly within the threshold for reporting purposes, many of its clients will have turnover above this level.

Considering this, Greyfriars Project Management will: -

1. Ensure that when internal recruitment is being undertaken, that the following is referred to:
